## Community Support

Kawartha Downs is committed to supporting the growth and prosperity of its communities by responsibly giving back and making a positive difference through its involvement in important local initiatives, including:

- **Cavan FC Soccer Club Facility Support** – Donate monthly use of Grandstand facility for soccer club meetings, award ceremonies, and club operations due to lack of clubhouse
- **Wiener Dog Races for Animal Welfare** – Host two seasonal fundraising races with \$20 registration fees, raising \$200 from 10 dogs in July 2024 and \$400 from 20 dogs in September 2024, with all proceeds donated to Peterborough Humane Society
- **Christmas Vendor Market Food Drive** – Host December 14, 2024 vendor market requiring non-perishable food item admission, collecting over 100 pounds of food for Peterborough Food Bank
- **Ontario Standardbred Adoption Society Golf Sponsorship** – Sponsor \$200 hole sponsorship for September golf tournament supporting horse adoption services
- **Curve Lake First Nations Pow Wow Support** – Provide \$8,300 total cost for arranging delivery and pickup of bleachers for annual Pow Wow held September 21-22, 2024
